Other dignitaries in the audience were also recognized – Scottsdale City Councilman Linda Milhaven, Jini Simpson – past PRWC President and Paradise Valley town council member, Leona Johnston – past AzFRW President and Dottie Puskar – past program chairman of PRWC Current elected board members were also recognized.

Judy explained our newest fundraiser "Queen of Hearts" game. 52 cards are pinned to a board face down. Tickets are sold for \$1 each -1 ticket is drawn and the winner gets to turn over 1 card on the board. \$20 for an Ace, \$10 for a face card - the Queen of Hearts wins half of all the money collected from the start of the game.

Recording Kiosks are available in 7 library locations throughout the county. Documents can be scanned and recorded on the spot. She is also in charge of Elections and early voting. There are over 2 million registered voters in the county. 81 o/o vote on an early ballot. Questions and answers followed her talk.
