GENERAL MEETING - MAY 14, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 11:00 by President Judy Lawrence. Janet Hiatt gave the invocation and led us in the Pledge.

Judy announced that Paradise has 6 Delegates going to the National Convention in Cleveland. She then introduced our first speaker, Thayer Verschoor, President of the Arizona Republican Assembly. "AzRA" is a conservative "watch-dog" group that rates elected Republican officials on their adherence to the party platform and conservative values. Our second speaker was Jason Hayes, Assistant Director of the American Coal Council. He addressed the EPA regulations that are strangling the energy industry. Coal is a cheap, abundant energy source and provides 34% of US energy, followed by natural gas and nuclear. Wind, solar and other sources account for less than 5%. The EPA is trying to shut down the Navajo coal-fired power plant near the Grand Canyon, blaming it for the haze in the Canyon. Mr. Hayes contends the haze is due to the smog in Los Angeles.

Mark Lewis of SRP answered some questions about solar power – he is running for the CAP water board.

Dr. Jana Jackson, running for Maricopa County Superintendent of Schools and Jay Lawrence, running for re-election in LD 23 also spoke briefly.
