Mark Spencer is the Southwest Project Coordinator for Judicial Watch.

Mark has lived in Phoenix, AZ since 1975 and was the top overall police recruit from the Phoenix Regional Police Academy in 1987. While still a sworn first responder, he partnered with Federation for American Immigration Reform (F.A.I.R.) and Judicial Watch reference to front-line law enforcement perspectives on illegal immigration and government corruption. Mark discussed the history and mission of Judicial Watch. This organization started in 1994 during the Clinton Administration as an American conservative non-partisan watchdog group that files Freedom of Information (FOIA) Lawsuits to expose alleged misconduct and of government officials such as Clinton Email Scandal, Phoenix Airport Tarmac Meeting, Illegal Russian Leaks and others.

Tom Jenney is Director of the Arizona chapter of Americans for Prosperity, formerly the Arizona Federation of Taxpayers was our Keynote Speaker discussing the budget, legislative scorecard, school choice, and the ESA Program. Tom also discussed the difference between the Flat Tax and the Fair Tax. The Americans for Prosperity Organization was founded by the Koch Brothers in 2004 as an anti-taxation advocacy group. It is a grassroots operation promoting lower taxes, less government regulations and economic prosperity for all Americans.
