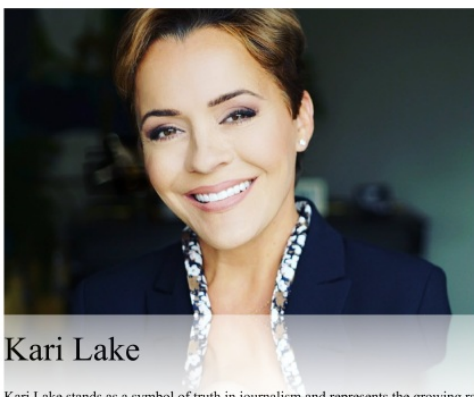

Kari Lake

Kari Lake stands as a symbol of truth in journalism and represents the growing ranks of journalists who have walked away from the mainstream media market peddling fake news.

Lake is a former evening anchor for FOX10 News in Phoenix, Arizona where she informed viewers for more than two decades. Kari Lake and her co-anchor, John Hook, were the longest running anchor team in the country and had a successful run as the number one rated news team for most of their 22 years together. Lake is a household name in Arizona—trusted for her fair coverage of stories affecting the state since 1994.

She stunned viewers when she resigned in 2021 at the top of her game and blew-the-whistle on the dishonesty and bias in the media. Lake walked away from a lucrative and high-profile career. In a video announcing her departure to Arizona viewers, Lake expressed concern about how journalism has changed since she first entered the news business, "I don't like the direction it is going. The media needs more balance in coverage and a wider range of viewpoints represented in every newsroom at every level and in each position."

Lake said she no longer felt proud to be a member of the media and no longer wanted to read "news copy that [she] did not believe was fully truthful or only told part of the story." She decided she had to leave after realizing by remaining she was contributing to the fear and division in America.

Lake credits her return to her faith for finding the courage to step into the unknown and leave a safe job saying she seeks guidance each day by asking God to "use her as He sees fit."

Lake has won Emmy Awards and AP Awards for her reporting and anchoring. Some of the most memorable are stories took her to the landmine fields of Cambodia, to the White House—twice.

The following information lists some ways that you, as a concerned Republican & American citizen and Arizona resident can stay informed.

Get on the mailing lists, go onto websites & social media, see what's going on and how you can get involved. Become a Precinct Committeeman to be active in your LD. Know your party officials and know your local, county, & state representatives. Let your voice be heard.

The Arizona Legislature is in session working on bills. Go to the website to see what bills are in process; what bills your representatives are supporting; and learn how to make your voice heard with writing letters or getting on the Request to Speak platform. The National Federation of Republican Women has a great website for national updates. After your local membership is activated, you will receive updates from our state and national federations. Once your local membership is activated, you can log onto your NFRW account.

If you have any questions, ask one of the board members. Many of our local and state government entities allow citizens to watch meetings and sessions in process. Please seek out these opportunities to be involved and get first hand information. If anyone in our club has an interest in being a liaison to our government bodies, please let a board member know.
